


Market Insight DUNS TRANSFORMATION WIZARD


The Market Insight DUNS Transformation Wizard will allow you to pull multiple family trees at the same time. The Duns Transformation Wizard Icon can be found on your tool bar in the "Wizards" tab.



You would start by clicking on the DUNS Transformation Wizard icon which will open up the following screen:





The drop-down list on this screen will allow you to define what type of linkage you would like to see on your selection of records. The wizard defaults to "Full Corporate Family" which is what most customers would choose. You also have several different options of family tree views you can select.




Once you select which linkage view you would like to see click "Next".

This step will require you to drag and drop the selection of DUNS/Records that you want the family tree data on into the window that says "Drop your selection/Duns Numbers file here"







When your selection is dropped in the text box click "Next". The next step would be to identify which Market Insight folder you would like to save your selection to. You can save the file in your Public or Private folder.




Once you select which folder you would like to save your selection to give your selection a "File Name" The example file name in the screen shot above is "US DUNS Number Family Trees" click "Finish."



The Market Insight tool is now pulling all the related family member DUNS Numbers that are tied to your selection. Once the Wizard is complete you will get a screen that looks like this below. Click the green "RUN" button.



You will now see in the lower right hand corner of the screen the total number of family members DUNS/sites that are linked to your original input selection. There are 25,816 total DUNS/sites in this family tree selection.



Now you can drag and drop a Data Grid, Cube, or Tree onto this selection of records to begin your analysis and get to the details of these sites. In my example below I dropped a "Data Grid" onto this selection so I could see the business details of these records.
