




How to Rename a Cube Dimension


- Drag a variable onto a Cube dimension
- > Right click on that dimension and select the option Rename Dimension...
- > Enter the new description in the box that appears and click **OK**



How to Rename Dimension Headers


For some dimension types such as queries, query sets and numeric bandings the header values can be renamed.

- > Create a query such as Sites with SIC of Automobile Assembly and/or State of Michigan
- Drag this query onto a Cube dimension
- > Right click on that dimension and select the option Edit Dimension Values...
- ➤ Rename the heading descriptions as appropriate and click **OK**



How to Rename a Statistic

- > Drag a variable e.g. **Income** onto a Cube dimension
- > Right drag a numeric/currency variable e.g. **Cost** onto the Cube and select **Mean(Cost)**
- Click on the Statistics icon to display the Statistics window
- Click on the Edit... button on the Mean(Cost) row
- > On the window that appears check the box **Use Custom Statistics Name** and enter an appropriate description
- ➤ Click **OK**



How to Reorder Cube Statistics

- Click on the **Statistics** icon to display the window where each statistic is shown as a separate row
- > Click on the statistic you want to move and drag to its new position in the hierarchy
- ✓ N.B. A red line appears to indicate when dropped were a statistic will be inserted.
